### FNSB Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQG\*)

*Required to make an appointment and are charged the following: (Note: 1 gal or 1 lb minimum.)*

#### Flammables: \$4.00/gal

- Alcohols
- Blazo

- Toluene
- Xylene




#### Used Oils: \$3.00/gal

- Motor Oil
- Diesel
- Kerosene

#### Batteries: \$5.00 each

#### Paint: \$8.00/gal

- Adhesives
- Latex Paint
- Oil-based Paint 


#### Toxics: \$13.00/gal

- Fertilizer
- Mercury
- Perchloroethylene
- Pesticides
- Poisons

#### Corrosives: \$7.00/gal

- Acids
- Caustics

#### Miscellaneous: \$5.00/lb

- Absorbent Pads

\* **Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG)** – A generator (Business) is a Very Small Quantity Generator in a calendar month if it generates ≤ 100 kg (220 pounds) /month of hazardous waste, ≤ 1kg (2.2 pounds) /month of acute hazardous waste, and ≤ 100 kg (220 pounds) /month of acute spill residue on soil. - See 40 CFR 262 for complete requirements.
